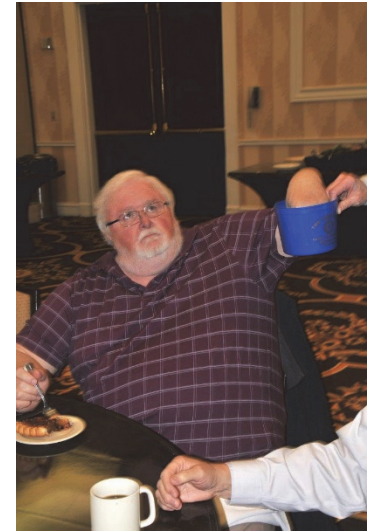
**December 2 Meeting

Past President Ted Hayes selected the winning raffle tickets.



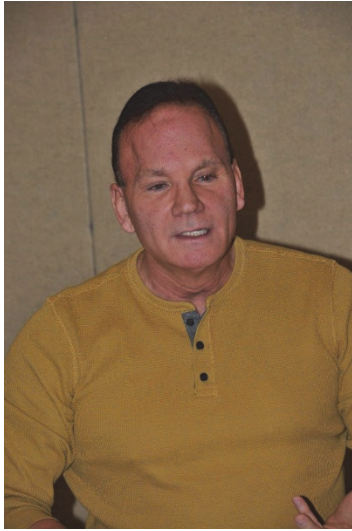
Past President Stewart Carlin and **Amy Erskine** greeted members and guests.



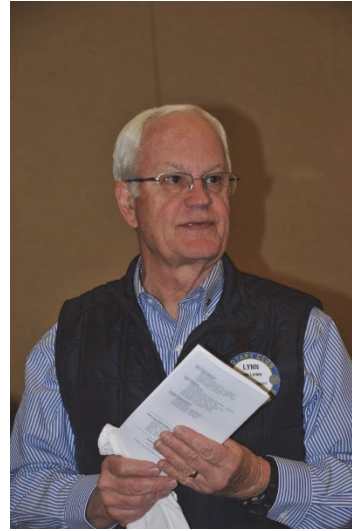
Past President Stewart Carlin conducted the Carithers Scholarship raffle, introduced guests and gave a Meet the Rotarian talk.

Chris Stokes modeled his White Elephant gift.



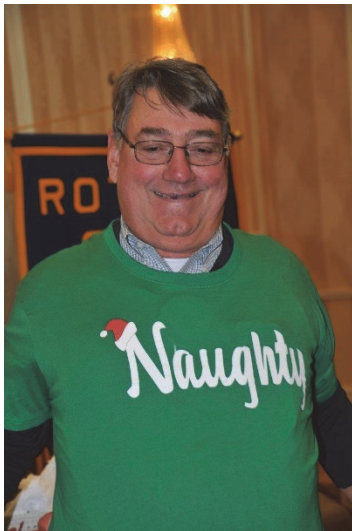
Past President Rosemary Martin unwrapped a seed tree.
