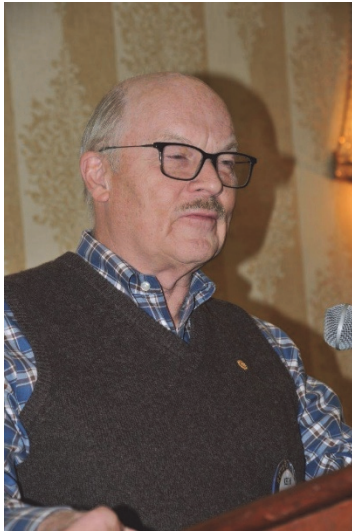

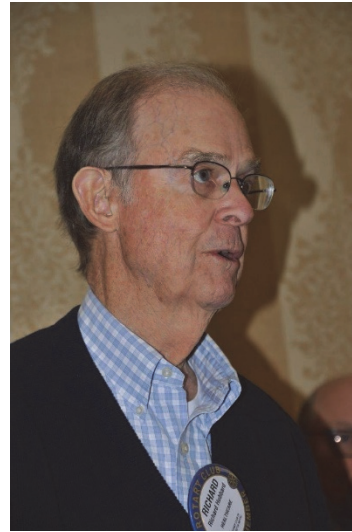

Richard Hubbard conducted the invocation, led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test and gave a Meet Your Rotarian talk.



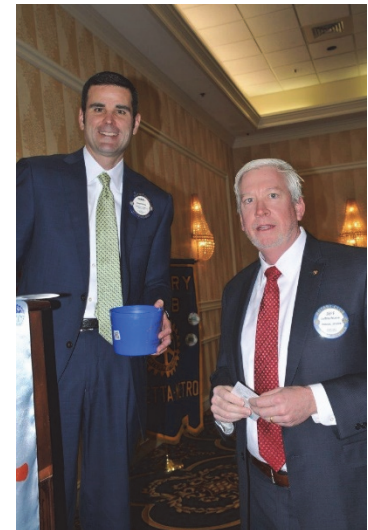
Officer Cole of the Marietta Police Department selected the winning raffle ticket.
