Jake Cheatham Award

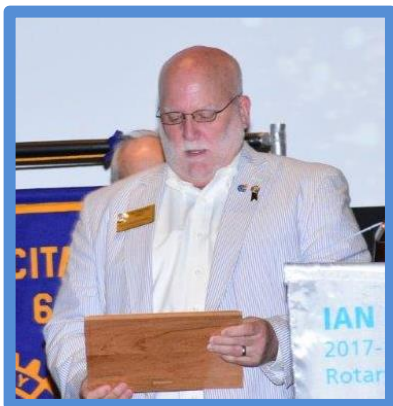
