When the Cobb Galleria was built, he was called to manage that facility, and in 1995, before the Atlanta Olympics, he was called back to the WCC as the assistant GM. Thereafter, he was promoted to the GM. The GWCC is the 4th largest convention venue in the United States. Chicago's McCormick Center is the largest in the US. Presently, the GWCC is comprised of three buildings. The plan in the future is to connect two of the buildings, so that larger shows can be booked, in a contiguous space. The Rotary International Conference to be held in June 2014 will be hosted at the GWCC.
